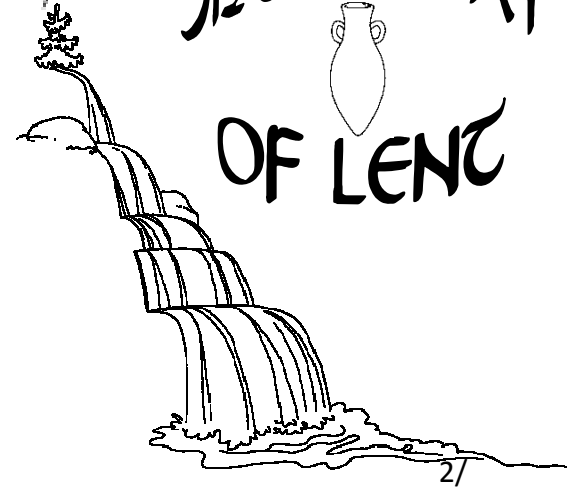

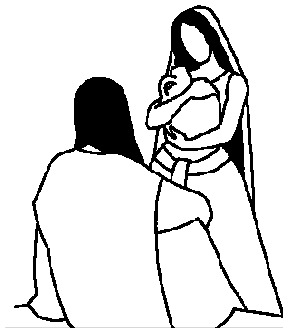

The flock that is let by his hand.**

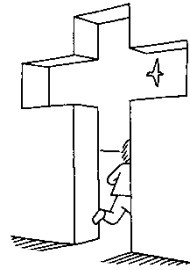
